Dear Mr. Feise:

This letter is to inform you that we have received allegations that you have violated the following University policy specified in the *University of California Policies Applying to Campus Activities, Organizations, and Students*:

- **Section 102.05:** *"Theft or abuse of University computers and other University electronic resources such as computer and electronic communications facilities, systems, and services. Abuses include (but are not limited to) unauthorized entry, use, transfer, or tampering with the communications of others, and interference with the work of others and with the operation of computer and electronic communications facilities, systems, and services. (See Appendix K).

Use of University computer and electronic communications facilities, systems, or services that violates other University policies or campus regulations."*
- **Section 102.07:** *"Violation of policies, regulations, or rules governing University-owned, -operated, or -leased housing facilities or other housing facilities located on University property."*
- **Section 102.13:** *"Obstruction or disruption of teaching, research, administration, disciplinary procedures, or other University activities."*
- **Section 102.16:** *"Failure to identify oneself to, or comply with the directions of, a University official or other public official acting in the performance of his or her duties while on University property or at official University functions; or resisting or obstructing such University or other public officials in the performance of or the attempt to perform their duties."*


The alleged policy violations are related to computer use policies and the installation and distribution of software that is not compliant with Housing Guidelines.

You may obtain a copy of these policies, free of charge, from the Office of the Dean of Students located in T-100 Humanities Trailer Complex (on Ring Road across from Humanities Hall), or access the policies on the Internet at <http://www.dos.uci.edu/judicial/index.php>.

Please contact my office at (949) 824-5590, Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., to schedule a meeting with me as soon as possible. According to the University's due process procedures, you have seven (7) business days from the date of this letter to arrange a meeting date. Prior to our meeting, you may seek legal advice and/or advice from the University Ombudsman. If you do not arrange a meeting by **November 10, 2006** or fail to keep an appointment, an administrative hold will be placed on your student

records, prohibiting you from performing any registration transactions or using University facilities (e.g. library, recreation facilities, etc.). This hold will remain on your records until the situation is resolved. A review also may be conducted in your absence, should you choose not to respond.
